Please bring your Health Examination List (with HAP ID; TRN; Application ID) to proceed with e-Medicals.

Important Notice

Children under 18 years must be accompanied by a parent or a legal guardian, who can sign a consent form and take decisions on their behalf.

Fees

Item	eMedical Requirement Codes	Fee in USD
Medical Examination : Above 11 years	501 and 502	123
Medical Examination: 5-11 years	501	82
Medical Examination: Below 5 years	501	80

Fees for additional tests if required

Item	Fee in USD
HIV test	5
Hepatitis B test	5
Hepatitis C test	5
Urinalysis	2

Fees include:

- Physical examination including complete history taking and vital signs.
- Chest X-ray with additional views, if needed
- Additional testing of sputum smears and cultures for tuberculosis (TB), if needed based on the Chest X-ray findings; repeat chest X rays as 603 deferrals and also chest physician consultations.
- Treatment for TB, if diagnosed positive for TB upon investigations

Fees do NOT include:

- Additional investigations or specialist referrals which may be required to establish or clarify a diagnosis.
- Any costs associated with the applicant's stay in Kathmandu, including costs related to a long-term stay for TB treatment
