Special Advice to New Zealand Health Assessment

- Please bring Health Examination List (with NZER; NZHR etc.) of e-medical information to proceed with e-Medicals. The MHAC staff can assist you to go for Up Front Medical.

Fees

Item	Fee in USD
General Medical Certificate – Applicants aged above 15 years	148 USD including additional blood tests listed in the below table
General Medical /General Certificate – Applicants aged below 11 years	USD 75
Limited Medical Certificate – Applicant aged above 15 years	USD 100
Limited / General Medical Certificate – Applicant aged 11 to below 15 years	USD 85

Fees for additional tests if required

Item	Fee in USD
Serum Creatinine	5
HIV	5
HB surface antigen	5
Hepatitis C	5
CBC	5
RPR	5
Hb A1C	15
Urine Pregnancy Test for female from 12 to 54 years old	5
Sputum smears and cultures	100

Fees include:

- Physical examination including complete history taking and vital signs.
- Chest X-ray with additional views, if needed

Fees does NOT include:

- Any additional investigations or specialist referrals which may be required to establish or clarify a diagnosis.
- TB investigations and treatment if diagnosed positive.
- Any costs associated with the applicant's stay in Kathmandu, including costs related to a long-term stay for TB treatment

Submission of documents on E medicals

- Usually the submission on line takes place within 72 hours.
