Special Advice for US-bound immigrants

- Please bring along with you if you already have an Interview Appointment letter from the US Embassy or a National Visa Centre letter (NVC) showing Visa application process details.
- For Visa 93 or Visa 92 applicants: please bring your interview letter or approval letter from the US Embassy.
- Please bring Three photographs in the same format as for the US visa (2"X2" with a white background)
- Please bring your vaccination record, if available as the US requirement includes vaccination.
- Children from 2 to below 15 years of age group need a blood test called IGRA for TB infection. It is done on three days in a week Monday; Wednesday and Friday. Results will be available within 48 hrs.
- US medical documentation will be completed for those who have normal results within a maximum period of 48 hours. The information of the collection date will be provided after the medical examination.

Important Notice

Children under 16 years must be accompanied by a parent or a legal guardian, who can sign the consent form and take decisions on their behalf.

Fees include:

- Physical examination including complete history taking and vital signs.
- Chest X-ray with additional views, if needed
- Blood drawing, serological test for syphilis, including confirmatory test and treatment for syphilis, if needed
- Tuberculin skin test might change to IGRA blood test with effect from 1 OCT 2018 as per US requirement
- Additional testing of sputum smears and cultures for tuberculosis (TB), if needed based on the Chest X-ray findings
- Treatment for TB, if diagnosed positive for TB upon investigations, and also chest physician consultations
- Reviewing and transcribing vaccination records but doesn't include the vaccination service fee
- Pregnancy test, if needed

Fees does NOT include:

- Additional investigations, which may be required to establish or clarify a diagnosis, including psychiatric evaluation.
- Any costs associated with the applicant's stay in Kathmandu, including costs related to a long-term stay for TB treatment
